6th steering committee meeting and study visit
Umbria Region (Italy)

On the 15th June 2011 at 9 a.m. the Steering Committee of FATE project will be held in Sala Fiume-Palazzo Donini, Perugia (Italy).

Umbria region is a partner of FATE project, Financed by the South East Europe Programme. The other partners are from Hungary, Slovenia, Greece, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Serbia, Croatia and Friuli Venezia Giulia Region is the lead partner.

The project aims to find identify models of conversion and management of military brownfields, the final purpose is to create Business Support Centres and Business Incubators starting from the brownfields. The project started in 2009 was born and it has collected the needs necessary to give a productive use to the military brownfields of the partners' territories. In many cases the management of brownfields has been transferred from a central level to the local government. The project has implemented the following activities: analysis of regional context and potentialities of brownfields in each involved territory, objectives sharing with public and private entities, production of a feasibility analysis.

This meeting is one of the lasts before the end of the project fixed in december 2011 and it will focus on the discussion about the implementation, about feasibility plan and communication to local community.

After the Steering Committee it is organised a visit to the Foligno Incubator to share the umbria experience in enterprise building, moreover there will be a visit in Spoleto. The Steering Committee will be opened by Claudio Tiriduzzi, director of the Service of Community Planning of umbria Region and will be coordinate by Manuela Fischanger, FATE manager for Friuli Venezia Giulia Region.
